

Uniform Policy from September 2022 – published July 2022

We are conscious that parents will already be thinking about uniform requirements for September and are starting to buy new and/or replacement items. With that in mind, we thought it helpful to communicate our approach to uniform this coming academic year to help plan for those items you'll need. Crucially, this is slightly different to the approach we've had to take during the Covid pandemic.

The **default uniform is either the Winter or Summer uniform**. In most weeks, this will be worn on more days than Sportswear.

On the two days of the week where children have timetabled Games and PE, they can come to school in their Sportswear, negating the need to change during the day. The same is true for Years 3 to 6 on those days where they have a sporting fixture.

For children in Years 3 to 6, if they have a sporting enrichment activity after school including Martial Arts, they come to school in their Winter or Summer uniform and get changed into Sportswear at the end of the school day in our supervised changing rooms.

For children in Years 1 and 2 taking part in the Multisport session or Martial Arts after school, they should come to school in their Sportswear.

For lunchtime sporting activities, there is no requirement for children to wear Sportswear — with the exception of Cross-Country Club who can come to school in Sportswear — though children may wish to change their footwear for Basketball, Handball and Dodgeball.

In Years 3 to 6, the children will be on a 5-week rotational programme on Tuesdays or Fridays that will include Outdoor Education and Gymnastics. When the children are participating in Gymnastics, they can come to school in their Sportswear. For Outdoor Education, they can come dressed ready for the activity though it's important that the children bring the following:

- o change of footwear (wellies/walking boots)
- o warm layers (including long sleeves)
- o tracksuit bottoms/leggings
- o a waterproof coat note that the tracksuit tops are not waterproof, therefore a suitable waterproof coat should be brought to school in addition to this.

The days that Sportswear will be required will be finalised with you at the start of the autumn term.

On a separate note, we have been working with our clothing supplier, SchoolBlazer, in relation to replacing the white Sportswear items at the earliest opportunity which, given existing stock, will be September 2023.

Purchasing Uniform

You will find below the individual uniform lists for girls and boys in both KS1 (Reception to Year 2) and KS2 (Years 3 to 6). All items marked **Grange** must be bought from our supplier Schoolblazer via their website (www.schoolblazer.com). Other items may be bought from our supplier or elsewhere. The terminology used for the items is designed to be consistent with the Schoolblazer website to enable you to easily select appropriate items of clothing.

High standards of appearance are part of the culture of the school and so the guidance below is to help you make sure that the children are dressed appropriately during each of the terms.

Winter and Summer Uniform

As well as for individual comfort, practicality and smartness of appearance, the uniform is designed to provide clothing options that are suitable for the seasonal changes we experience in the UK i.e. we have a winter and a summer uniform. The table below indicates when summer or winter uniform should be worn throughout the school year, recognising that sometimes the climate is not always as we would prefer in the summer months! Please refer to the uniform lists for items included as winter or summer uniform – crucially, we ask that the children wear the combinations as indicated.

Hair and Jewellery

Hair must – whilst in school uniform – be clean, sensible, neat, kept away from the eyes and of a natural colour, in line with the high standards that the school sets for uniform and appearance. Children should have long hair tied back in school using plain green, black or brown hair accessories.

Children are not allowed to wear any jewellery except a watch or medi-alert items, nor may they wear make-up or nail polish. If children have their ears pierced, we ask that this done at the beginning of the summer holidays so as not to restrict them from taking part in Games, PE and Swimming should they have it done at another time.
