A smart appearance is required at all times, including travelling to and from school.

- You are a role model to younger pupils
- You represent the school when showing around visitors and parents
- You must aim to enhance the reputation of The Grange School in the community

The following dress code offers guidance, but be aware that your overall appearance is more important than the details of specific items of clothing. As a rule of thumb, what you wear to school should be suitable attire for a customer facing business environment.

Formal occasions (Prizegiving, Open Mornings, School Photographs...)

- Formal suit
- Plain white shirt with tie / smart white formal top
- Dark leather / leather appearance shoes appropriate for wearing with a suit

Everyday

- A formal suit or
- Smart formal trousers with a complementary jacket **or**
- A smart formal dress / skirt with a complementary jacket

Please note: **Sixth Form students must wear a jacket at all times**. This includes any lunchtime visit to Hartford.

- Trousers, dresses and skirts must of an appropriate length and not be too tight fitting. Jeans, skorts and shorts are not permitted.
- A smart formal top or collared shirt. A tie should be worn with a collared shirt.
- Shoes must be appropriate for wearing with a suit in a professional workplace. Trainers are not acceptable.
- Smart jumpers and cardigans are permitted provided they do not have a large logo. Sweatshirts and hoodies are not acceptable.
- Hair must be neat and of a natural colour.
- Outer coats can be worn to and from school, but must only be worn around the school site when it is particularly cold or raining.

The final decision as to what constitutes an appropriate appearance rests with The School.
